December 4, 2016 Scripture: John 3:31-36 (NAS) Topic: "The Superiority of Jesus" Rev. Bruce Gardner

- 31 "He who comes from above is above all, he who is of the earth is from the earth and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all.
- 32 "What He has seen and heard, of that He testifies; and no one receives His testimony.
- 33 "He who has received His testimony has set his seal to this, that God is true.
- 34 "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure.
- 35 "The Father loves the Son and has given all things into His hand.
- 36 "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

I. JOHN'S HUMILITY

- A. Much About John's Life We May Deem Praiseworthy

II. JOHN DECLARED JESUS' SUPERIORITY

- A. Jesus' Heavenly Origin Matthew 1:18-20; Luke 1:30-35
 - 1. Jesus is "from above" vs. 31
 - 2. John knew himself to be earthly Matthew 11:2-3
 - 3. Jesus, the bread from above John 6:33, 38-39
- B. Jesus Has Firsthand Divine Knowledge
 - 1. Untaught with full knowledge
 - 2. At age 12 Jesus confounded the temple leaders
 - 3. He knew all intuitively, eternally Hebrews 1:1-2

C. Affirming Christ Declares God Is True

- 1. Jesus later claimed to be truth John 14:6
- 2. Jesus is truth personified
- 3. The Father affirmed the Son at his baptism and transfiguration
- 4. Failure to believe in the truth of who Christ is calls God a liar *I John 5:10*

D. Jesus Was Given The Spirit In Full Measure

- 1. Prophets, apostles were given the Spirit only in part
- 2. Jesus was given all the gifts of the Spirit

E. Jesus Was Granted The Father's Love

- 1. All things were given to him Ephesians 1:21-23
- 2. All the redeemed are His John 10:27-30
