

# **SERMON NOTES**

January 22, 2012 Scripture: Luke 20:9-18 (NAS)

Topic: "Authority Accompanies Rightful Ownership"

- 1 And He began to tell the people this parable: "A man planted a vineyard and rented it out to vine-growers, and went on a journey for a long time.
- 2 "At the harvest time he sent a slave to the vine-growers, so that they would give him some of the produce of the vineyard; but the vine-growers beat him and sent him away empty-handed.
- 3 "And he proceeded to send another slave; and they beat him also and treated him shamefully and sent him away empty-handed.
- 4 "And he proceeded to send a third; and this one also they wounded and cast out.
- 5 "The owner of the vineyard said, 'What shall I do? I will send my beloved son; perhaps they will respect him.'
- 6 "But when the vine-growers saw him, they reasoned with one another, saying, 'This is the heir; let us kill him so that the inheritance will be ours.'
- 7 "So they threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. What, then, will the owner of the vineyard do to them?
- 8 "He will come and destroy these vine-growers and will give the vineyard to others." When they heard it, they said, "May it never be!"
- But Jesus looked at them and said, "What then is this that is written: 'THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED, THIS BECAME THE CHIEF CORNER stone'?
- 10 "Everyone who falls on that stone will be broken to pieces; but on whomever it falls. it will scatter him like dust."
