Scripture: Hebrews 3:12-19 (NAS)

Topic: "Be Careful"

- 12 Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God.
- 13 But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.
- 14 For we have become partakers of Christ, if we hold fast the beginning of our assurance firm until the end,
- 15 while it is said, "TODAY IF YOU HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS, AS WHEN THEY PROVOKED ME."
- 16 For who provoked Him when they had heard? Indeed, did not all those who came out of Egypt led by Moses?
- 17 And with whom was He angry for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness?
- 18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who were disobedient?
- 19 So we see that they were not able to enter because of unbelief.
